1.0 Summary

This internal audit review provided an evaluation of Jemison's current level of conformance to the ISO 9001:2015, against the current internal audit schedule. The audit measured how effectively the quality management system is implemented in conformance with the applicable requirements and standards. **Based upon our review, the QMS is effectively implemented.**

Audit Detail/Observations/Findings

7.5 – Documentation Requirements

The following forms and documents were verified during the audit: CLV-RC-001 Receiving Procedure (Quality Intranet-no hard copy present), JDM-F-001Mill/Receiving Information Rev-2, JDM200 Quality Policy Rev-1 (Multiple locations, listed in hardcopy listing), Auto-generated work order from Stelplan (PN: 72853), CLV-RB-002 Rev 4, FQA066 (Calibration Worksheet) Rev 3, Auto-generated loading order from Stelplan (CLV 121527, Unified Brands).

7 Support

Employees appeared competent and well trained. Adequate resources (gauges, safety equipment, operating equipment, environment) were observed during the audit.

7.2 Competence

Reviewed JDM-F-014 Rev 0, training status matrix. Employees were clearly identified as to competence levels.

8.2 Requirements for products and service

Kidron production on P/N 72853 was a consignment stock production job. We produce to planned stock levels. Each Wednesday, customer sends a consignment "needed" list that sales confirms this same day via email. They also send a P.O. for what's been used from consignment.

8.4 Control of externally provided processes, products and services Mill coil GA18808 was utilized against Jemison PO 26365 and was received on receiver 49426. Purchase grade met the requirements of the customer part specification. Material was specified as ASTM A1011 HSLA Grade 50 class 1. Minor Finding #1: GA18808 did not have the mechanical properties listed on the tag per the requirements of ASTM. This was corrected during the audit; however, a CA should be put in place to fix the root cause of the missing information.

8.5-Production & Service Provisions

Receiving: Was unable to audit receiving in real time. Reviewed receiving paperwork of PO 26365 Receiver 49426. Sandy Damato performed 1st receiver duties, while Kathy Manka performed 2nd receiver duties.

Production: Work order 72853, Kidron, was observed on CR2 (Redbud). Operator was John McCullough. All checks performed per Redbud Operating procedure (CLV-RB-002) and the customer part specification requirements. Thickness, width, length, flatness, packaging, # tags/bundle, and 3,000 lb max weight were all within work order requirements (see notes for further details).

Preventive Maintenance: Reviewed with Larry Strimple, Schedule calendar for June reviewed. All schedule maintenance marked as performed. A-Bay Crane (Receiving, Serial # 92146, monthly inspection was performed on 6/19 on form MF056 Rev 3). Minor Finding #2: Annual crane inspections (by outside crane company) were not available during the audit. Last documented crane inspections were in 2017. RBI 2 Preventive maintenance checklist (for June) was reviewed. All items were documented as performed on June 10th.

Nucor Gallatin & AWL Trucking verified to be on the Approved Supplier Listing.

7.1.5 Monitoring and Measuring Resources

The following gauges were verified to be calibrated in compliance with calibration records: Receiving: 16' Tape Measure, #10; 2 rockwell hardness testers (81121 & 869015). Opportunity for Improvement #1: 81121 had a calibration report, but not a certificate of calibration like 869015. It is in calibration, but should probably get the certificate as well. Also recommend getting updated versions without white out on them. Redbud: 24" calipers, 081; 16' Tape Measure #1; 0-1" Micrometer, ASP016.

8.7 Control of Nonconforming Product

Both sheet and coil nonconforming areas were well defined and neat. Coil area had zero items. Sheet area had multiple items and all were identified and tagged correctly.
